To comply with the requirements of Wakefern, a major trading partner, D'Arrigo Brothers implemented an EDI system to submit 810 invoices electronically. As part of the EDI process, D'Arrigo Brothers also implemented an eBridge integration solution that automatically moves data from their AccountMate application to create and send the invoices.

With the eBridge integration solution, D'Arrigo streamlined their EDI process by eliminating manual data entry and accompanying errors, while also speeding up the accounts receivable payment cycle, as invoices are received sooner by the trading partner.
